A total of 72 units in graduate (200+) or approved upper-division undergraduate (100-199) courses must be completed with a grade of at least "B" in each course. No more than 20 units in upper-division courses (100-199) may count toward the degree. The normative time to degree for students in the M.F.A. program is two years. Residence is required.
