PH.D. DRAMA AND THEATRE 2024-2025 Degree Requirements

The following 10 required seminars must be completed by the end of the 3rd Year & a minimum of one seminar per academic year must be taken in the UCSD Dept. of Theatre & Dance: **Drama 290:** Dramatic Lit and Theatre History Prior to 1900 (2 courses) 8 units **Drama 291:** Dramatic Lit and Theatre History, 1900 to Present (3 courses) _____ 8 units **Drama 292:** Cultural and Critical Theory (4 courses) 2 Additional Seminars Additional required courses: Drama 293: Directed Studies Drama 294: Dissertation Research **Drama 399:** University Teaching (4 courses) **Optional Emphasis in Dramaturgy: Drama 244:** Dramaturgy: Theory and Methods (1 course) _____ 4 units **Drama 297:** Dramaturgy Practicum (1 course) 4 units **Drama 290 or 291** (1 course) Foreign Language Requirement (must be completed by end of 3rd Year): Comprehensive Examinations - 1st Year Written Exam: Advancement to Candidacy: Qualifying Exam Students MUST advance to candidacy no later than the end of fall quarter of their 4th Year. 2nd Year Winter Quarter: Select advisor 2nd Year Spring Quarter: Select committee (one from each campus) Develop area of dissertation focus and reading list 3rd Year Fall Quarter: Prospectus due 3rd Year Winter Quarter: Qualifying paper due 3rd Year Spring Quarter: Oral exam

A total of 144 quarter units in graduate (200+) or approved upper-division undergraduate (100-199) courses must be completed with a grade of at least "B" in each course. Forty of these units are taken in required seminars; the balance is made up of elective seminars, independent study and research projects (including preparing the three qualifying papers), and dissertation research. Normative time for completion of the degree is five years; total registered time in the Ph.D. program at UCI or UCSD cannot exceed seven years.
