MFA Comprehensive Examination: This is a special field exam, related to (but not limited to) repertoire selected for the Graduate Recital. It is taken no later than March of the second year. The graduate committee sets the exam 24 hours in advance; the student makes an oral presentation and then fields the committee's questions.

A total of 51 quarter units in graduate (200+) or approved upper-division undergraduate (100-199) courses must be completed with a grade of at least B in each course. The normative time to degree for students in the M.F.A. program is two years. Residence is required.
